he craft store: All those neat little projects, just waiting to be accomplished. If you are lucky and focused, you'll end up with just what you need without wandering around until you're worn out. When that happens, you'll end up with new scissors, a random skein of yarn, and a new craft idea -- but not all the right tools.

There is an alternative. Craft subscription boxes are all the rage and for good reasons.

They are delivered to your door once a month with all the necessary supplies and instructions to complete a project. No random yarns hanging around your home. No missing glue. You have everything you need.

If you don't get one finished, you can easily cancel the next box.

The curated boxes offer new ideas. A scrapbook box, for example, might give you a selection of papers that you

You can also try your hand at different crafts. Some boxes offer beginner projects with different crafts each month. Make a bead necklace one month and craft string art the next. Try some paint pouring after that. Next month, make some soap. After that, make some cards.

If it turns out that you just hate the craft, you haven't invested a fortune. Boxes range in price from \$30 to \$60 and you can usually cancel anytime.

On the other hand, a trip to the craft store can be a lot of fun, especially when the store offers groups to learn and practice different crafts. Knitting groups bring beginners and experienced people together, for example, so you can solve problems and get help.

Medicare Open Enrollment starts October 15

From October 15 to December 7 you can change your Medicare options during the annual open enrollment period.

During this time, you can join, drop, or switch to Medicare Advantage Plans or to Original Medicare.

Medicare Advantage plans, known as Part C, are a Medicareapproved health plan that is an alternative to Original Medicare. The Advantage plans are offered by private companies and they must follow Medicare rules.

Advantage plans cover Part A (hospital insurance) and Part B (medical insurance). Most include Part D (Medicare prescription drug coverage.)

Some Advantage plans offer additional benefits such as hearing, vision, dental or wellness programs.

While most Advantage plans require you to use a doctor in the network, they may have lower out-of-pocket costs than Original Medicare.

Also during Open Enrollment, you can add or drop drug coverage.

One thing people don't realize is that you can make as many plan changes as you want during Open Enrollment. If you make a mistake, you can choose a different plan before December 7.
